Sacred Miniature Clan Poles

The original 30 foot tall Sunray Peace
Village Clan Pole welcomes visitors to the
Peace Village, the spiritual home of the
Green Mountain Band of the Ani Yun Wi
Wa (Cherokee). It was rendered in 2013 by
internationally recognized sculptor,
Reinhard Reitzenstein.

We are offering limited edition miniature clan poles, created by the sculptor of the original clan pole.

Each miniature clan pole:

- Is cast in bronze, museum quality
- Is part of a limited edition of seven (only 5 still available)
- Measures 18 inches tall by 2 inches wide
- Is signed and dated by the artist
- Is valued by The Olga Korper Gallery, Toronto, at \$9000.00 US

Through the Sunray Meditation Society, you can now purchase this sacred icon for \$7000. All proceeds benefit the Sunray Peace Village.

The Artist's Process:

I thank Venerable Dhyani Ywahoo for placing her trust in me to create this sacred Clan Pole at the Sunray Peace Village.

Preparing for the project, I carved a miniature model of the pole in basswood, testing my creative ideas. When I transferred these images to the full-scale Clan Pole, I could anticipate how to handle each clan image, visually and energetically.

After completing the large Clan Pole, I realized that the miniature model of the clan pole could be offered to the community and friends by creating a limited edition in bronze.

Seven wax replicas were cast in bronze using the lost wax process, a process over ten thousand years old.

Seven replicas were made to remind us of the Seven Sisters, or Pleiades star system, sacred to the Cherokee people.
