Retreat Camping Rates

- **Individual camper rates:** \$25.00/night, \$120.00/week, \$375/month.
“**Individual**”: 1 adult or 1 adult and child(ren) 14 and under, in a single tent
- **Tent rates:** \$40/night, \$180/week, \$550/month.
“**Tent**”: 2 or more adults (15 & above pay the adult rate), Children 14 & under are free.
- **Native American Campers** - Traditional offerings are welcome
